

# Community Information Notice

## Changes to Industry Activities during Gold Coast Commonwealth Games 2018

The Department of Environment and Science (DES) regulates a number of industries within the Ormeau/Yatala/Luscombe/Cedar Creek area.

Some of these industries will operate under different conditions during the Commonwealth Games to avoid traffic and reduce congestions. As a result, you may see and hear heavy vehicles moving to and from these sites outside of their standard operating hours.

The following quarries and landfills in your area are affected by these temporary changes:

- Boral Quarry Yatala
- Boral Quarry Ormeau
- Fulton Hogan Blue Rock Quarry
- Hanson Wolffdene
- Holcim (Beenleigh Quarry)
- City of Gold Coast Landfill Stapylton.

Environmental authorities for the quarries have been amended to enable operators to preload truck and semi-trucks, dispatch and receive deliveries and allow movement of trucks on site outside of normal operating hours. Table 1 specifies after hours operating times when these activities are permitted at these sites.

The environmental authority for City of Gold Coast Landfill has been amended to allow for waste disposal activities to occur outside of the normal operating hours at the Stapylton landfill. Table 2 specifies the extended operating hours for this landfill.

Operators are still required to implement appropriate management measures to reduce noise and impacts on surrounding sensitive places.

Residents in close proximity to these sites will receive a letter informing them of the proposed changes, which details the complaint process if there are any issues.

Any changes to operations on these sites will be managed in accordance with the environmental authority conditions and for the quarries these changes will only occur between 2 April 2018 and 16 April 2018, and for the landfill between 19 March 2018 and 20 April 2018, after which normal operating conditions will resume.
